

§ 150.04 DESTROYED OR UNINHABITABLE STRUCTURES; REMOVAL OF DEBRIS.

In the event any building is destroyed by fire or other acts of God or man or so nearly destroyed as to render it uninhabitable for a place of residence or a place of business necessitating a reconstruction of the premises, then it shall be the duty and responsibility of the owner of the property, within 90 days after the destruction or near destruction of the premises, to clean up the debris and remove same from the premises. In the event the owner of the property is not able to do so within 90 days, he may appear before the City Commission in regular session and request from them sufficient time to clean up the premises telling them the reason or reasons why same has not been accomplished within 90 days provided.
