

§ 36.11 AUXILIARY POLICE FORCE.

(A) An Auxiliary Police Force is established by this section for" the city pursuant to KRS 95.445.

(B) The Auxiliary Police Force shall have no more than four members at any one time. All members will take the Oath of Office required of police officers by state law.

(C) Appointments shall be made by the Mayor and Commission after an applicant has successfully completed pre-employment testing administered by the Department of Criminal Justice Training. Recommendations by the Chief of Police shall be taken into consideration when making appointments.

(D) Qualifications for appointment as an auxiliary member shall follow KRS 95.710.

(E) The power and duties of the Auxiliary Police Force shall be same as the regular Police Officers for the city pursuant to KRS 95.740.

(F) Auxiliary Police Force members are sworn, non-paid members. All members are gratuitous volunteers of the city who are not entitled to any compensation or other monetary benefit for their time, service, or expense unless otherwise specified and approved by the Mayor and Commission.
