

§ 51.10 CITY ASSISTANCE IN CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION AND COLLECTION.

(A) The city shall contribute the sum of \$100,000 from its general fund, with the funds to be transferred to the District's Construction Fund to be maintained by the District upon receipt from the District of a commitment of loan funds in the amount of \$761,000 for installation of the system.

(B) The city will execute a Memorandum of Agreement between the city and Warren County Water District regarding utilization of Kentucky Community Development Block Grant funds for purposes of acquisition, construction, and installation of certain additions to the District.

(C) The city will cooperate with the District and assist in the collection of connection fees in the sum of \$500 for all residences and \$1,000 for all business, commercial, industrial and other establishments. Fanners Home Administration requires that \$129,000 in connect fees be on deposit with the District prior to the District taking construction bids on the system. The city shall not be entitled to a return of any sums deposited in the "1993 Sewer System Construction Fund" pursuant to division (A) of this section.

(D) The city will assist and cooperate with processing any grant application in the city's name and provide such data, surveys or other information as may be required for processing of such grants.
