

KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK WITHIN THE CITY

§ 90.40 DEFINITION.

For the purpose of this subchapter, the following definition shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

LIVESTOCK. Includes cattle, horses, mules, colts, jennets, cows, bulls, hogs, goats, sheep, jacks, fowl and all livestock of any description kept or raised for use, pleasure and profit. Domestic dogs, cats, rabbits and caged birds are specifically excluded from this definition and this subchapter shall not apply thereto.
