

## ***SIGNS***

### **§ 91.60 POLITICAL SIGNS.**

(A) No person shall place a political sign ("Political Sign") on any property if such sign does not conform to the regulations herein.

(B) Also, no person shall permit to be placed on his or her property a political sign that does not conform to the following regulations:

- (1) The maximum size of each political sign shall not exceed 16 square feet.
- (2) Only one political sign per candidate is permitted in each yard or one political sign per candidate is permitted in each yard or property. A two-sided sign is permitted, but not placed in a "V" shape or other alignment to expose more than two message surfaces.
- (3) All political signs must be placed not less than the greater of:
  - (a) At least five feet back in the yard from the inside edge of the sidewalk; or
  - (b) At least 15 feet back in the yard from the edge of the road pavement.
- (4) The top of the political sign may not exceed five feet in height from surface of the ground.
- (5) No political signs are permitted in a street right-of-way or on public property.
- (6) No political sign shall be placed so as to block traffic visibility on a corner lot.
- (7) No political sign may be installed more than 60 days prior to the date of the election to which it pertains.
- (8) All political signs must be taken down and removed within five days after the election to which it pertains.
- (9) No political sign may be posted on any vacant lot, unless written permission of the property owner is filed with the City Clerk.
