Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Wednesday, April 14, 1965

The Board met at the McGuffey Insurance Agency with one member, Trustee Frank Jordan absent.

Carl Rasdall was present and gave a detailed up-to-date report on the progress which has been made toward the purchase of the water system. Mr. Rasdall and Mr. Bevarly made a trip to Atlanta and were well pleased with the engineers, etc. Any recommendations which are made are being carried out. The Board appreciated this report.

1. Motion was made by Trustee Carl Ferguson and seconded by Joe Lowe that Mayor Bevarly be authorized to sign as an authorized officer of the City of Smiths Grove the Assurance of Compliance with the Housing and Home Finance Agency Regulations Under Title VI of The Civil Rights Act of 1964. There were no dissenting votes.
2. Motion was made ~~and seconded~~ by Trustee William Powell and seconded by Trustee Joe Lowe to adopt the attached ordinance regarding the shooting of firecrackers, etc. There were no dissenting votes.
3. The Kentucky Inspection Bureau has again recommended that a drying rack be made available for the fire hose and also that additional hose be purchased. Chairman Bevarly is to discuss this with Henry Priddy and do the necessary.
4. Clerk is to write to Frankfort regarding the stationing of a State Policeman in our town.
5. Spring clean-up was discussed and it was decided to set the week of May 3 as clean up week.
6. Clerk is to write letter regarding the committee for the erection of the chapel at the cemetery advising the administrator of the estate that we will keep them informed.
7. It was the general opinion of the board that political banners not be placed across the street.
8. Chairman Bevarly was authorized to call the County Attorney to see what steps need to be taken to force David Perkins to clean up his filling station debris.
9. Clerk and Mr. Bevarly will check on the availability of stop signs. Also, it has been requested that the speed signs be moved to the present limits of the city.
10. Clerk is to again contact Earl Anderson regarding the accumulation of junk cars around this repair shop.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
