Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, August 7, 1953.

The Board met as usual at 7:30 PM, in the Director's Room of the Deposit Bank. After being called to order the following business was transacted:

1. The Clerk was directed to write to Mr. S. Ford Thomas requesting that he cut weeds at corner of lot at College Street and Stock Street as it is dangerous for people to get out into street.
2. The Clerk was directed to sell to Mr. John S. Sturgeon two graves adjoining Dr. B. K. Amos lot at the Cemetary in what was once a walkway for the sum of \$50.00. Deed was to be delivered to Mrs. John W. Cooke who will get check for same from Mr. Sturgeon.
3. A discussion was entered into regarding the water which stands in front of H. D. Irvin's residence on Stock Street. The Board refused to do anything further as Mr. Irvin refused to let a ditch be cut through his property so that water could drain into a sink back of his place.
4. Clerk was directed to send out notices that all taxes must be paid by September 15th or they will be turned over to the collector for collection.
5. The Clerk was directed to write to Eureka Fire Hose Company and tell them that they agreed to give us a foam extinguisher but instead sent an Indian fire pump, that they agreed to send hose within forty five days and bill us the first of September, that the hose must be forthcoming or else order will be cancelled.

There being no further business the Board adjourned until its next regularly scheduled meeting, the first Tuesday in September.
