The following Ordinance was passed regarding the sale of beer in bottles over the bar to be consumed on the premises, as follows;

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of Smiths Grove Kentucky to-wit:

That it shall be unlawfull to sell cold beer , in bottles, over the bar to be consumed on the premises after 6 P M. Ordinance was duly posted in three prominent places in the City. This Ordinance to be effective September 1st 1947
