

Second reading of Ordinance passed on December 4th 1946

Call meeting on December 11th 1946

The following Ordinance was passed by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Smiths Grove on their regular meeting night December 4th 1946 for the first reading- To-wit: 46-01

To purchase a building located on the main street of the town in which to store the Fire Truck, a City Jail and Court Room, The funds to pay for this building over a period of years to be obtained from a special fund and monthly savings on rents of a City Hall and storage place for the Fire Truck. Four members of the Board being present and all voting in favor of the purchase.

On this second reading of the Ordinance. The members of the Board of Trustees, hereby, authorize the City Clerk to borrow Twenty Five Hundred (\$2500.00) the purchase price of the building from the Deposit Bank of Smiths Grove Ky. to be payable in five notes of Five Hundred Dollars each one note of Five Hundred Dollars to be paid each year with interest at the rate of 6 %. annually.
