The Clerk gave a financial report. A discussion of guy lines being placed in wrong places by the telephone company, poles being put in wrong places and holes dug in the street was held. The Marshall was designated to talk to the telephone men about the situation.



The Clerk was also directed to write to F. B. Hardy in regards to the \$50.00 paid to him by Mrs. Ruth Bratton for two graves adjoining Mr. George Cole's lot at the Cemetery.

There being no further business the Board adjourned.
