

City Commission meeting - July 25, 1988 - City Hall - 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Gilley called the meeting to order with all commissioners in attendance.

AGENDA

Minutes of the previous meeting

Mayor Gilley called for additions or corrections to same, with none to be heard, Comm. Crisp presented a motion to accept the minutes as written, seconded by Comm. McGuffey. Roll call and vote - McGuffey yes, Crisp yes, Stiffey yes, Gilley yes, Belcher yes.

Minutes of special called meeting 7/18/88

Mayor Gilley stated that the exclusive purpose of this special called meeting was to open the sealed bids for the exclusive trash/garbage franchise. With no additions or corrections to these minutes, Comm. McGuffey presented a motion to accept them as written, seconded by Comm. Belcher. Roll call and vote - Belcher yes, Gilley yes, Stiffey yes, Crisp yes, McGuffey yes.

Treasurer's report

The Mayor called for discussion or corrections to this report. Comm. Belcher wondered if it was necessary to present a report every two weeks. The clerk said since this was the first report of the new fiscal year, it only contained two weeks. Usually the report is for a period of one month. With no further discussion to be heard, Comm. Crisp presented a motion to accept it as printed, seconded by Comm. Stiffey. Roll call and vote - Belcher yes, Gilley yes, Stiffey yes, Crisp yes, McGuffey yes.

First reading-Exclusive Trash Franchise Ordinance #88-1 830.1, (copy attached)

The above stated ordinance was presented to the commission for their consideration. Comm. McGuffey floored a motion to accept this ordinance for a second reading, seconded by Comm. Crisp. Roll call and vote - Belcher yes, Gilley yes, Stiffey yes, Crisp yes, McGuffey yes. The commission then discussed with Mr. Jerry Dobbs, Vice President of Monarch Environmental Inc. when would be a

good time for them to have the second reading of the ordinance. Mr. Dobbs answered; he would like to have it as soon as possible so they could notify the Smiths Grove residence when they would start their services. The commission then decided to have the second reading, Tuesday, 7/26/88 @12:30. The franchise contract will also be signed at this time.

OTHER

Eugene Waller had applied for a building permit to have Russell Janes erect a 24x42 wood frame garage at his residence. Comm. McGuffey said he had been to the Wallers and measured to make sure the garage would comply with the city's zoning ordinance. It would. With no further discussion to be heard, Comm. McGuffey presented a motion to allow this permit to be issued, seconded by Comm. Belcher. Roll call and vote - Belcher yes, Gilley yes, Stiffey yes, Crisp yes, McGuffey yes.

Comm. Stiffey wondered what the city could do to have the two wrecked vehicles which have been sitting on Main St. for a long period of time, removed. Chief Bybee said the State Police were already working on getting this done. The owner has moved, and they now become abandoned vehicles.
