Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, June 2, 1953.

The Board met as usual at 7:30 PM, in the Director's room of the Deposit Bank. After being called to order the following business was transacted:

1. The Clerk was directed to send in order for fire hose which was made out by a Mr. Simmons, salesman for Eureka Fire Hose Company. The order was for 500 feet of hose at \$1.90 per foot (total \$950.00). Mr. Simmons agreed to give the Fire Department a foam extinguisher as a bonus.

2. Chairman Melton is to check with Squire Anderson about blacktopping Street between College and Main Streets by Presbyterian Church.

3. The Clerk was directed to see Mr. F. B. Hardy about Cemetary lots.

4. The Clerk was directed to make deed for lot at Cemetary adjoining Dr. B. K. Amos lot to John S. Sturgeon for \$100.00.

5. A motion was made by Mr. Barlow, seconded by Mrs. Crump that a street light be installed in the lot or near the lot behind the bank so as to shine down alley in behind Garman and Son store.

6. A discussion of the teenage boys staying out late at night. The Board discussed the hours of closing the boys poolroom to prevent disturbances, etc. Mr. Barlow agreed to talk with Horace Marr about closing earlier.


7. A discussion of someone to take Thomas R. Madison's place on the Board. Since he had not resigned nothing was done.
