Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Wednesday, June 9, 1965.

The Board met at the McGuffey Insurance Agency with one member, Trustee Joe Lowe absent.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

1. Chairman Bevarly has been notified by Senator Natcher for the loan for the purchase and reconstructions of the water system has been approved. Progress will be made as soon as possible. It is possible construction might begin this fall.
2. The Kentucky Inspection Buarea has been infomed that the loan has been approved. Also, the fire station has been painted, the roof repaired and Roy Beckham is to build the drying rack in the near future.
3. Clerk is to contact Captain Sharpe regarding the location of A state Policeman here. The other prospect had three children and this size family was too large for the available apartment.
4. Clerk is to write Dr. Toomey of the State Health Department regarding the location of a health department annex in Smiths Grove in an effort to better serve parts of Warren, Edmonson and Barren counties.
5. Chairman Bevarly reported that Carl Rasdall has paid quite a few telephone bills for calls regarding the water system. All were in agreement he should be reimbursed.
6. The Hardy account has been paid with the exception of a \$75 bill against the Delma Steenbergen family and there is some question on this.
7. Motion was made by Trustee Carl Ferguson and seconded by Trustee Powell that the attached ordinance prohibiting the building of outside toilet facilites be adopted. There were no dissenting votes.
8. Motion was made by Trustee Jordan and seconded by Trustee Ferguson that the attached ordinance regarding uninhabitable buildings be adopted. There were no dissenting votes.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
