Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees on Tuesday, November 11, 1969

After a postponement of one week the Board met in regular session at the American National Bank and Trust Company with all members present. Visitors were Jack Walker, Jerry Neal Marr, Medford Skaggs and Maurice Marr.

1. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.
2. Judge Blue reported all is going well at the water station. A barrell went out when the water system was being installed. This has been repaired at a cost of \$991.
3. Joe Lowe reports no problems at the cemetery.
4. Medford Skaggs asked that the street be repaired between Broadway and 4th Street. Trustee Powell said he would have this patched with some black top.
5. Mr. Skaggs also inquired regarding a street light on Fourth Street. He was advised this installation has been authorized and we are waiting on the RECC. Street lights have also been ordered for the colored section, Highland Avenue and the Webb Subdivision. Chairman Melton said he would check with Mr. Stewart on this.
6. Dr. Hill inquired about a heater for the fire department. He was advised this has been installment. A discussion was held on the place of installation. Trustee Powell said he would check on having this moved so the heat will not blow on the hose and the new truck.
7. Jerry Neal Marr reported big trucks are tearing up Fifth Street.
8. It was reported that glass is being broken on the school ground. It was the consensus of members that this is private property and the Board should not intervene. It was hoped that after football season is over, this situation would clear up. Trustee Hill reported Jim Cullen is patrolling this section each $\frac{1}{2}$ hour after 11:30.
9. Jerry Neal Marr suggested that the fire station needs a general cleaning. Trustee Powell is to check on this.
10. Medford Skaggs complained about the condition of the Henry Thompson lot. Clerk is to write Mr. Thompson a letter.
11. The location of the fire siren was again discussed. This is to be done by the RECC.
12. Trustee Blackwell presented a bill for glasses for Jim Cullen and a statement from Dr. Fisher that this change was necessary due to the shooting. Dr. Hill made a motion that we pay \$26. Trustee Blackwell seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.
13. Jerry Neal Marr inquired as to why the speed limit for the city could not be moved out to the present limits. This situation is governed by the State.
