

City Commission meeting - November 25, 1985 - 7:00 p.m. - City Hall

Mayor Jackson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with all commissioners in attendance.

## AGENDA

1. Minutes of the previous meeting and the two special called meetings, 10/30 and 10/31/85 were presented for the commission's consideration. Comm. McChesney presented a motion to dispense with the reading of these three minutes, seconded by Comm. Gilley. Roll call and vote- Gilley yes, Marr yes, Jackson yes, McChesney yes, Garman yes.

2. Treasurer's report for the period 10/18/85 thru 11/15/85 was presented for discussion or corrections. With none to be heard, Comm. Marr presented a motion to accept the report as written, seconded by Comm. Garman. Roll call and vote - Gilley yes, Marr yes, Jackson yes, McChesney yes, Garman yes.

### 3. Annual Financial statement - Smiths Grove LIBRARY

Mayor Jackson distributed the report and gave the commission ample time to review it. Mayor Jackson turned the floor over to Wanda Jackson, Treasurer of the Library Board to answer any questions the commission might have. She stated the Library Board was very proud of the traffic increase at the library as well as the increase in the book circulation.
