

City Commission meeting - November 26, 1990 - City Hall - 7:00 P.M.

Mayor Gilley called the meeting to order with all commissioners in attendance.

1. Minutes of the previous meeting

Discussion or corrections to same were called for by the Mayor. With none to be heard, Comm. Belcher presented a motion to accept them as printed, seconded by Comm. McGuffey. Roll call and vote - Belcher yes, Gilley yes, McGuffey yes, Crisp yes, Lacy yes.

2. Minutes of the special called meeting

The Mayor stated the purpose of this meeting was to hear the second reading of the 1990 property tax ordinance. With no discussion to be heard, Comm. McGuffey presented a motion to accept these minutes as printed, seconded by Comm. Crisp. Roll call and vote - Belcher yes, Gilley yes, McGuffey yes, Crisp yes, Lacy yes.

3. Treasurer's report

Corrections or discussion of same was called for. The clerk said she wanted to inform the commission she had taken the funds in the general fund checking account and put a portion of it in a Now account and a portion of it in a Money Market so the city could be earning all the interest possible. With no further discussion, Comm. McGuffey presented a motion to accept the report as printed, seconded by Comm. lacy. Roll call and vote - Belcher yes, Gilley yes, McGuffey yes, Crisp yes, Lacy yes.

4. Discussion of a future street ordinance

The clerk had roughed out a potential ordinance for the commission's consideration. The commission had reviewed it prior to the meeting and with so many legal questions about it, they advised the clerk to meet with the city attorney to see if he could possibly help with one. She agreed to do so. Comm. McGuffey presented a motion to table this ordinance until such time the clerk could get

advice and guidance from the city attorney, seconded by Comm. Crisp. Roll call and vote - Belcher yes, Gilley yes, McGuffey yes, Crisp yes, Lacy yes.

5. Third quarter financial statement-Smiths Grove Cemetery

The commission had reviewed the report prior to the meeting and with no questions or discussion, Comm. McGuffey presented a motion to accept it as printed, seconded by Comm. Belcher. Roll call and vote - Belcher yes, Gilley yes, McGuffey yes, Crisp yes, lacy yes.

6. Other

The clerk asked the commission if they were going to have a meeting in December. Comm. Crisp said he felt it would be a good idea to do as in the past and only have a meeting if something arose that needed attention. All of the commission was in agreement.

With no further business to be discussed, a motion to adjourn was floored.
