Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Trustees on Thursday night,
November 9, 1967.

The Board met in regular session of the American National Bank and Trust Company with all members present. Visitors were Dr. James Hill, Bobby Joe Booker and Jack Walker.

1. Dr. Hill discussed the new zoning map. It was decided to wait for a special meeting when Mr. Kingsbury could be present to go into detail on the map and some necessary revisions. Dr. Hill is to contact Mr. Kingsbury and arrange for the meeting.
2. Chairman Melton presented an ordinance which had been prepared relative to a perpetual care fund to be established by the Smiths Grove Woman's Club. Each member was asked to read the ordinance. After a general discussion, Gene Blackwell made a motion that we not adopt the ordinance between the Town of Smiths Grove and the Smiths Grove Woman's Club. Trustee Joe Lowe seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.
3. The old water works building was discussed. Chairman Melton agreed to oversee the pulling of the wells in preparation for a sale to dispose of surplus material.
4. Trustee Powell reported that some street paving had been completed but he has not received all the bills.
5. Trustee Rasdall discussed the question of social security. Clerk is to write a letter to clarify this.
6. Parking on 101 was discussed but no agreement reached.
7. It was announced that Sunday, November 12, at 2 PM, the Myrtis Cole Memorial Chapel is to be dedicated.
8. There being no further business the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
