

Regular September Meeting Continued: Public Hearing on 1980 Tax Rate

A public hearing was held Monday October 13, 1980, at 6:30 P. M. in City Hall for the purpose of discussing the 1980 tax rate. The hearing was advertised previously in the Park City Daily News.

Those present were Mr. Crousore, Mr. Wolff, Mr. Barner, & the clerk. Mr. Wolff reconvened the September meeting. He then explained that the rate was to be reduced to 23.2¢/\$100.00 from 24.2¢ because of House Bill 44. This still allows the City to collect approximately 4% more revenue than last year due to the reassessments. But in order to collect the additional 4%, the City was required to hold this hearing.

Mr. Wolff read the Ordinance, (Attached) and moved its acceptance. Barner aye, Crousore aye, Wolff aye. Motion carried. The second reading of the Ordinance will be at the regular October meeting.

Mr. Crousore moved to adjourn.
