

Special called meeting October 5, 1976

The meeting of the Board of Trustees, City of Smiths Grove, was held approximately 8:30 PM Tuesday, October 5, 1976 at the new County Fire Station, Main at Laurel with the following members present; Chairman Margaret Bevarly, Dr. James S. Hill, Mrs. Shelvie Dubree, Mr. George Torrence and Mr. Matheny.

The meeting was called to order by Mrs. Bevarly and turned over to Mr. Matheny from the Planning and Zoning Commission. Mr. Matheny had the Board to look over an ordinance with a different floormat than Bowling Green's. The Board would decide later which one to use.

Discussion was then held on the Business zones. It was decided to have two business zones. One for central business for the businesses down town and one for the Highway businesses. The central business would not allow storage for gas above ground, it would require off street parking and lot width would be 50 foot minimum. The highway business district would have minimum of 2 acre lots, with minimum of 100 foot width of lot, with a set back of 25 feet and also off street parking and unloading zone, they would also maintain a rear set back.

Discussion was held on an industrial zone. It was decided to have only one industrial zone. Discussion was held on a conservation zone which would help preserve sinkholes. Also there was discussion on a public zone.

Being the time was late it was decided to adjourn until a later date.
