Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Tuesday, October 7, 1969. The Board met at the American National Bank and Trust Company with all members present. Visitors were Willard Cole, Jerry Neal Marr and Maurice Marr.

1. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.
2. Chairman Melton reviewed the present bank balance and the expenditures for the past nine months. The outgo is exceeding the income and unless we receive more income and the expenses remain the same, we will lack approximately \$1500 operating money.
3. Trustee Hill reported that Richard Kirby will obtain the signs for Dwight Anderson street.
4. Trustee Hill inquired as to the status of the Planning and Zoning Ordinance and the Board of Adjustments. Chairman Melton said he thought everything was being arranged. The Board is meeting. Judge Blue reported no permits had been requested. Chairman Melton had contacted Stanley Rice regarding these permits and will check with him again. Trustee Hill said Mrs. Proffit had no up-to date information.
5. Trustee Lowe reported no problems for the cemetery.
6. Trustee Blackwell made a motion that a fire phone be installed at the residence of Bill Pierce. Trustee Lowe seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.
7. Trustee Blackwell reported he had received a request for a street light between the Baptist and Christian Churches. It was the concensus of the Board that this problem could be solved with the installation of a security light by the Baptist Church. The visitors were also in agreement that this was the manner in which this request should be handled.
8. Trustee Powell reported that he is delighted with the work which has been done regarding the leak under the RR track. This work was accomplished at a much lower price than had been expected. Highway #101 is still to be repaired with the 2" black top and they will only accept hot mix. He is hoping to get this done within a few days.
9. The drain in front of the Carl Netherton property was discussed. It was decided this was State buisness and Bill Powell is to contact David Watkins regarding this situation.
10. Judge Blue said the water bill collections are about the same. The same ones are still behind.
11. Trustee Hill reported our ordinance reads that the penalty on the water bills will start the 14th while the cards read the 10th. Trustee Hill made a motion that the ordinance be amended to read the penalty will take effect ~~Qxton~~ on the 10th of the month. Trustee Blackwell seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.
12. Trustee Hill requested three more caution signs for children. Gene Blackwell made a motion that clerk order these signs. Trustee Lowe seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
