Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees Tuesday, September 6, 1966.

The Board met at the American National Bank and Trust Company with one member, Trustee Joe Lowe, absent.

Trustee Rasdall made a motion that Dr. James Hill be the citizens representative for Smiths Grove on the Planning and Zoning Committee of Bowling Green. Trustee Blackwell seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.

2. The Planning and Zoning Ordinance was read. Trustee Blackwell made a motion that this be adopted with the exception we are to have our own Board of Adjustment, handle our own finances and have our own inspectors. Trustee Powell seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.

3. The insurance bill for the Smiths Grove Water company was presented. The Board authorized payment.

4. Trustee Rasdall reported there is a metal tank which will not be needed in the new water treatment plant. The Board authorized him to advertise for sale. Also, there is some 4" piling which was damaged and he was authorized to sell this. He has been offered 50¢ per foot.

5. Trustee Rasdall reported there is a tree near the treatment plant which seems to be in good health. The Board is to decide whether this is to be removed or kept.

6. It was decided to have the 30 old water meters repaired at a cost of \$8 each including parts.

7. Chairman Melton reported he had a complaint regarding a stock truck and dogs belonging to Ray Vernon. Clerk was asked to write him a letter.

8. Chief Priddy and Firemen Bethel Denton and Bill Pierce came before the Board regarding the Aqualand Show which the fire department is sponsoring. They will need a telephone for two weeks. Clerk was asked to call the telephone company regarding the installation.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
