**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CONTINUITY OF GOVERNMENT IN
THE EVENT OF THE ABSENCE OR DISABILITY OF THE MAYOR.**

*** **

Ordinance No. 04-01 720.00, enacted on November 22, 2004, and relating to
"Continuity of Government" is hereby repealed in its entirety.

WHEREAS, the Warren County Fiscal Court deems it necessary to provide for the
orderly succession of the Office of Mayor of Smiths Grove in the absence or disability of
the Mayor when involving a National, State or Local emergency:

NOW THEREFORE be it **ORDAINED** to provide for continuity of government during a
national, state or local emergency the following described succession will take place:

When the Mayor of Smiths Grove is absent or disabled as defined in the Note below, the
Mayor Pro Tem will be notified by the Mayor or City Clerk to perform the duties and
responsibilities of the Mayor until the Mayor is no longer absent or disabled.


In the event that both the Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem are absent or disabled as defined in
the Note below, during a national, state or local emergency, then the duties of the City
Commission will be assumed temporarily by the Warren County Fiscal Court until either
the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem are no longer absent or disabled. The City Clerk will make
the applicable notifications to the Warren County Fiscal Court.

NOTE: The Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem will be deemed "absent" when he or she is
outside of the county at the time of the occurrence or declaration of the emergency
and is unable to return; and will be deemed "disabled" when sick, injured or mentally
incompetent to perform the duties of the office.


