ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, an ordinance was duly passed and approved on the 5th day of April, 1943, creating, and providing for the sale of, a franchise for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telephone exchange and system in the Town of Smiths Grove, Kentucky, for a period of twenty (20) years, and

WHEREAS, due advertisement and notice of the sale of said franchise was given as provided in said ordinance and said franchise was offered for sale on the 19th day of April, 1943 as provided in said ordinance, and

WHEREAS, Southern Continental Telephone Company at said sale did bid the sum of \$93.60 for said franchise and delivered to the Treasurer of said Town a certified check in said amount in payment of its bid (Southern Continental Telephone Company already owning in said Town a telephone plant and equipment sufficient to render the service required under said franchise, and at the time of said sale having obtained an order from the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, preliminary to the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, permitting said company to apply for and obtain such a franchise from said Town) and said bid being the highest and best bid received for said franchise,

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SMITHS GROVE, KENTUCKY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

The bid of Southern Continental Telephone Company in the sum of \$93.60 made for the franchise created by the ordinance duly passed by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Smiths Grove, Kentucky on the 5th day of April, 1943, be and the same hereby is declared to be the highest and best bid therefor and the same is hereby accepted and said franchise is hereby awarded to said Southern Continental Telephone Company, its successors and assigns.
