

ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky, in regular session on this the 9 day of June, 1965:

It is hereby ordained and ordered that in the event any building be destroyed by fire or other acts of God or man or so nearly destroyed as to render it uninhabitable for a place of residence or a place of business necessitating a reconstruction of the premises, then it shall be the duty and responsibility of the owner of the property to within ninety (90) days after the destruction or near destruction of the premises to clean up the debris and remove same from the premises. In the event the owner of the property is not able to do so within ninety (90) days, then he may appear before the Board of Trustees in regular session and request from them sufficient time to clean up the premises telling them the reason or reasons why has not been accomplished within the ninety (90) days provided.

Any person failing to do so shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$50.00 and each day the premises are not cleaned up shall constitute a separate offense.

Upon roll call of the Board of Trustees present, the vote was three yeas and no nays and the Chairman of the Board declared the motion passed.
