The Board of Trustees of the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky adopted the following resolution at a specially called meeting of the Board held on the third day of December, 1984:

WHEREAS, Allene Compton has filed an application for a rezoning of 13.39 acres of land located on Highway 101 at the southwest corner of I-65 Interchange at Smiths Grove, Warren County, Kentucky from Agriculture to B-4 (Highway Business); and

WHEREAS, said property has minimal access to State Highway 101 and is located at the interchange of Highway 101 and I-65 in a location that is hazardous as evidenced by many serious traffic accidents that have occurred in the past; and


WHEREAS, said property is located in an area which is a agricultural and residential in character and there have been no changes of a significant social or economic nature in the immediate vicinity.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky requested the City-County Planning Commission of Warren County, Kentucky to deny the application of Allene Compton for a rezoning of the 13.39 acres of land located on Highway 101 at the southwest corner of I-65 Interchange at Smiths Grove, Warren County, Kentucky from Agriculture to B-4 (Highway Business).

WHEREAS, the proposed rezoning is, in the opinion of the


Board of Trustees, inconsistent with the master plan for the City of Smiths Grove and County of Warren.






