**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE PROHIBITION OF USING  
FIREWORKS IN THE CITY OF SMITHS GROVE, KENTUCKY.**

**WHEREAS**, effective April 14, 1965 it became unlawful for any person to use fireworks in the corporate limits of the City of Smiths Grove with applicable fines ranging from \$10.00 to \$100.00: and

**WHEREAS**, such restrictions are rarely enforced and because the Kentucky Revised Statutes have been changed to allow the safe use of fireworks;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDINANED** by the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky Commission that:

Ordinance 65-1 1020.2, enacted on April 14, 1965 and relating to the restriction of the use of fireworks in the City of Smiths Grove, is hereby repealed in its entirety.”

Passed on Second Reading by roll call vote and adopted the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April 2013.
