AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF BID OF MRS. ADLAI A. KIRBY FOR FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, LAY, MAINTAIN, OPERATE, REPAIR, AND REMOVE WATER MAINS, WATER PIPES AND CONNECTIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSPORTING, DISTRIBUTING AND SELLING WATER FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE USE ALONG, OVER, UNDER AND ACROSS THE PUBLIC STREETS, AVENUES, LANES, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC GROUNDS AND TO OPERATE A SYSTEM OF WATER WORKS IN THE TOWN OF SMITHS GROVE IN WARREN COUNTY, KENTUCKY, FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY YEARS.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTERS OF THE TOWN OF SMITHS GROVE, KENTUCKY, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the bid of Mrs. Adlai A. Kirby in the amount of book which amount hasheretofore been paid to the Clerk of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Smiths Grove, Kentucky, for a franchise to construct, lay, maintain, operate, repair and remove water mains, water pipes and connections for the purpose of transporting, distributing and selling water for public and private use along, over, under and across the public streets, avenues, lanes, alleys and public grounds and to operate a system of water works in the town of Smiths Grove in Warren County, Kentucky, for a period of 20 years, be and the same hereby is, accepted.

That the franchise for the purpose aforesaid will be in full force and effect with her as the purchaser and owner of same for its full term of 20 years, which franchise in no wise is exclusive, on the day following the posting of this ordinance required herein and as endorsed by the Clerk at the bottom of same.

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and after its endorsement and approval by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees duly attested by the Clerk of the Board of Trustees and posted as required in three public places in the Town of Smiths Grove.
