ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SMITHS GROVE ACCEPTING THE CONVEYANCE OF THE ODD FELLOWS CEMETERY.

Passed Dec. 2, 1947. 47-1

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, a great many of the people of Smith's Grove, Kentucky, who have made their residence here in the past but now passed away, have been buried in what is known as the Odd Fellows Cemetery near the city;

AND WHEREAS, on account of its proximity it is to the best interest of the people of this city to own, maintain, and operate the said Cemetery for the benefit of the people;

AND WHEREAS, the city has been offered the said Cemetery with all its rights and appurtenances conditioned upon maintaining the same and carrying out and fulfilling the obligations of the charter of the original Cemetery Company granted under an Act of the Legislature of Kentucky in the year 1868;

NOW, the Board of Trustees of the City of Smith's Grove, Kentucky, does ordain as follows:

That this city shall and does accept the conveyance of said Cemetery without other costs than fulfilling the obligations of the said original charter of 1868 upon the following conditions, to-wit:

- 1. That a good and proper conveyance shall be made of a good title in and to said Cemetery to the city of Smith's Grove, Kentucky, and
- 2. That at the same time when said deed is delivered there shall be paid to the city the sum of \$500.00 to be expended in surveying, platting, or mapping the said Cemetery or improving its grounds or otherwise rehabilitating the same in the discretion of the Board of Trustees.

This Ordinance shall be signed by the Chairman of the Board, attested by the Clerk and posted in at least three public places in the city and shall be in force from and after its publication or posting.
