ORDINANCE PROPOSING ANNEXATION

November <sup>4</sup>\_\_\_\_, 1964

The Board of Trustees of the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky, does ordain as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED that the following defined boundaries of territory are proposed to be annexed to the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky, and this ordinance shall be advertised by copies of this ordinance being publicly displayed in four of the most public places in the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky; and be it further ordained that the ordinance of annexation shall be presented to the Board of Trustees of the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky, at their regular meeting to be held in December, 1964, which meeting shall be not less than thirty (30) days from this date. The property or territory to be annexed is described as follows:

TRACT NO. 1: Beginning at a point on Kirby Street 185 feet West of Highway 101 and at the present corporate limits of the city of Smiths Grove; thence 1790 feet parallel with Highway 101 to a stake; thence in an eastwardly direction 185 feet to the right of way of Highway 101; thence in an eastwardly direction along the right of way of the Interstate 65, 1250 feet to a stake; thence in a northerly direction 2350 feet to a stake, which stake is 310 feet East of Highland Avenue, the present boundary of the corporate limits of the City of Smiths Grove.

TRACT NO. 2: Beginning at a stake on the L & N right of way, which point is 190 feet East of the present corporate limits of the City of Smiths Grove, which point is 190 feet East of Kentucky Street; thence in a northerly direction 1900 feet parallel with Kentucky Street; thence to the left in a westwardly direction 2390 feet, to the present corporate limits of the City of Smiths Grove, which point is 180 feet North of Kentucky Street, the present corporate limits of the City of Smiths Grove.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a map clearly defining and showing the area to be annexed may be seen in the office of the Mayor of the City of Smiths Grove.

This November 4, 1964.

Upon motion of Trustee Jordan second by-  
Trustee Ferguson, it is moved that the above ordinance to annex be adopted and passed by the Trustees of the City of Smiths Grove.

Upon a roll call, the vote was 4 yeas and 0 nays and said motion carried.
