## ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky, in regular session on this the 9 day of June, 1965:

It is hereby ordained and ordered that henceforth after the adoption of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for there to be constructed within the corporate limits of the City of Smiths Grove outdoor toilet facilities.

Be it further ordained that the constrction of outdoor facilities and the use thereof is a hazard to the health of all of the residents of this City and endangers the lives of all of the citizens in this City creating a nuisance and a health hazard.

It is further ordained that any person violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$50.00; and each day that the said outdoor toilet facilities stand, shall be considered a separate offense.

Upon roll call of the Board of Trustees present, the vote was three yeas and no mays and the Chairman of the Board declared the motion passed This June 9, 1965.
