

ORDINANCE REGULATING PLACEMENT OF ACCESSORY BUILDINGS

ORDINANCE 77- 4

920.5

WHEREAS, the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky is aware that the addition of accessory buildings on lots with existing residences are necessary; and,

WHEREAS, these accessory building have in the past have caused problem to exist in the neighborhoods; and,

WHEREAS, the City feels both needs should be met now,

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Smiths Grove, Kentucky, a sixth class city in the County of Warren, in the state of Kentucky, that accessory buildings be allowed to be placed on a lot with existing residence if they are placed directly behind the residence and set back 10 feet from the back property line and no closer that 10 feet to either side property line.
