

Special called City Commission meeting - April 19, 1988 - 12:30

Mayor Gilley called the meeting to order with all of the commission in attendance.

Mayor Gilley explained the purpose of the meeting was to open the sealed bids received for the possible issuing of a franchise for the trash/and or garbage service for the city. (copies attached). Mayor Gilley ask the clerk if she would make copies of the bids for each of the commission. She did so. The commission then reviewed the bids and discussed each. Lindsey Sanitation had not bid their total to include the use of a 90 gallon container on wheels, which the bid proposal plainly stipulated. On the grounds of this error, Comm. Belcher presented a motion to reject Lindsey's bid, seconded by Comm. McGuffey. Roll call and vote – Gilley yes, McGuffey yes, Crisp yes, Belcher yes, Stiffey yes: The commission then discussed and compared the other bid proposals from Monarch Environmental and Commercial Sanitation. All agreed they would go over them with much care and report their opinions at the regularly scheduled meeting, April 25, 1988.

With no further business to be heard, a motion to adjourn was floored.
