Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Tuesday, April 2, 1968.

The Board met in regular session at the American National Bank and Trust Company with all members present and three visitors, Medford Skaggs, Bill Pierce and Jack Walker.

- 1. Chairman Melton asked the visitors if they would like to state their business or stay for the whole meeting. Mr. Pierce and Mr. Skaggs were asking for signs as a means of traffic control for speeding on their street. There are lots of children who play on this street and cars are speeding. The Board agreed to erect "children at play" signs and also Mr. Pierce and Mr. Skaggs agreed to sign warrants for known speeders. Mr. Melton promised them be Board would back them up.
- 2. Chairman Melton advised the plans for the factory are just about complete. A letter has been written to the Secretary of the Treasury in Washington with a copy to William Natcher, Carl L. Shipley, and Jim Kane advising them of the progress on the factory and also asking for assurance that the bonds will be tax free. The bonds are now being printed. Tentative plans now are to be in the factory by September.
- 3. **Chairman** Trustee Powell reported the factory could be hooked on the water system for an approximate cost of \$355.
- 4. Trustee Hill reported things are all right and running smoothly in the police department.
- 5. Parking at the post office was disquissed and it was decided when the side walk is complete, parking will be restricted on both sides of first street during post office hours.
