

**MINUTES
SMITHS GROVE CITY COMMISSION SPECIAL MEETING
MUNICIPAL ROAD AID HEARING
SMITHS GROVE MUNICIPAL BUILDING
MONDAY APRIL 27, 2015 6:30 P.M.**

Members present: Mayor Stiffey, Commissioner Vincent, Commissioner Cannon.

Members Absent: Commissioner Stiffey, and Commissioner Stidham

Also present: City Attorney Wes Milliken

Mayor Stiffey called the meeting to order at 6:34 pm.

Mayor Stiffey informed all present that this was the annual Municipal Road Aid Hearing that the city is required to have every year regarding the funds the city receives and how they will be spent. He explained that these funds may only be spent to maintain the city streets.

Mayor Stiffey stated that the city expects to receive around nineteen thousand dollars (\$19,000) this fiscal year in Road Aid funds. However, with the passing of House Bill 299 we assume that we will not get as much in the upcoming year.

Mayor Stiffey explained that this money comes from Kentucky Fuel Tax and that House Bill 299 has changed the way these funds will be calculated and distributed. Therefore, there is no way to know exactly how much we may receive.

At this time Commissioner Gary Vincent made a motion to approve the use of Road Aid money on the city streets for the upcoming year. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Cannon. There was no further discussion so the roll was called. Ayes all members present so the motion passed with a vote of 3 – 0.

The meeting was recessed at 6:37 pm until the Regular Commission meeting at 7:00 pm.
