Special called City Commission meeting - August 15, 1991

Mayor Gilley called the meeting to order with Comm. Crisp and McGuffey in attendance. He explained the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the hiring of a temporary police officer. He said he knew the commission had agreed to take their time in selecting someone, but in view of the vandalism that had occured the previous night, he felt that it was necessary to have someone on duty now. The commissioners agreed. He said Audie Montgomery, a former Warren County Deputy Sheriff, had contacted him and said he would be interested in helping the city out on a temporary basis as a police officer and night watchman. The commission discussed this and agreed this was what was needed.

After this discussion, Comm. McGuffey presented a motion the city hire Autie Montgomery on a 60 day basis as the city's policeman and night watchman, for the existing salary and gas and car allowance, seconded by Comm. Crisp. Roll call and vote- Crisp yes, Gilley yes, McGuffey yes. Mayor Gilley then invited Mr. Montgomery into the meeting so he could issue him the oath of office.

With no further business to be heard, the meeting was adjourned.
