Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees Tuesday night, August 2, 1966

The Board met in regular session at 7:30 P. M. at The American National Bank and Tuust Company with one member, Trustee Gene Blackwell absent.

Clerk reported a payment of \$1900 on the fire truck note. This leaves a balance due of \$1534.93.

2. Lawrence Stiffey, Constable, was present and Clerk was authorized to pay him \$14.50 for three fines which had been levied by Judge Blue.

3. There has been some difficulty in finding a solid foundation for the erection of the water tank but this is expected to be worked out in a satisfactory manner.

4. Gerald Brown, water clerk, was present and said that collections of meters and bills is coming along fine. Trustee Powell made a motion that all bills pertaining to the maintenance and operation of the water works be padd. Trustee Lowe seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes

6. Trustee Joe Lowe gave the cembtery report in the absence of Mrs. Jordan. The Hardy account is now only \$140.

7. A discussion was held as to the installation of water in the Ray Hendrick building which was rented to the State Forestry Division. It was the general opinion of the Board that he should pay for the tap-in and the water line.

8. Chairman Melton and Trustee Rasdall had attended the last meeting of the Planning and Zoning Board and it was generally agreed that we should cooperate and belong to this group. Our town would be zoned but we would have our own inspectors. This will be discussed further at another meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
