

Called Meeting Augst 2, 1977

The called meeting of the Board of Trustees, City of Smiths Grove was held at the new County Fire Station, Main at Laurel, Smiths Grove, Kentucky at approximately 7:30 PM with the following members present; Chairman Margaret Bevarly, Mrs. Brenda Belcher, Mrs. Shelvie Dubree, Mr. George Torrence and Dr. James S. Hill. The purpose of this meeting was to interview applicants for the policeman.

The meeting was called to order by Mrs. Bevarly and the Board asked to interview each applicant separately.

Mr. Rex Beller Route 2, Alvaton was the first. He now works with the Sheriff's Dept. He had a high school education, 2 years at Western University and he had completed 10 weeks of KLEC. He lives at Alvaton which is 22 miles from the City and he stated that there was no possibility of moving to Smiths Grove.

Mr. Azel Miller, Lot 21 Shivelane Estates, Bowling Gree. Mr. Miller stated that he could move his trailer to Bonayr Trailer Park which would be approximately 5 miles from the City. He stated that he had been a Deputy Constable since 1970 and that he had only finished 7th Grade. The Board explained that the car would be furnished by the officer and that the police would be on call at all times.

Mr. Steve Carter, Box 34, Smiths Grove, Mr. Carter had no experience in this field but he said he knew the people. He had an 8th Grade education but he was willing to work toward his GED. He lived on #101 about 2½ miles from town. He said he owned a 1972 Chevrolet which he could use on the job.

Discussion was held and it was decided that Mr. Beller could not be considered due to his location. It was decided to wait until next Tuesday to make a decision and see if any one else was interested in the job. Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
