The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martin. Gerald Brown stated that he would like to have as part of the Binding Elements the provision that any sidewalks torn up by construction be replaced. Mayor McCay stated that in order to include that provision, the rezoning recommendation would have to be sent back to Planning and Zoning and another public hearing conducted. When a vote was called for, Commissioner Cooke asked if the vote was for the recommendation sent to the City by Planning and Zoning. Mayor McCay answered in the affirmative, and the roll call vote continued as follows: Cooke yes, Varner yes, McCay yes, Martin yes. The City Clerk was instructed to send copies of the ordinance to the Daily News for publication and to Planning and Zoning.

The second reading of Ordinance #02-10, levying the 2003 annual property tax on motor vehicles and watercraft having a situs in Smiths Grove, was held, and Commissioner Varner moved to approve the ordinance. Commissioner Cooke seconded the motion. With no questions or discussion on the motion, the roll call vote was as follows: Cooke yes, Varner yes, McCay yes, Martin yes.
