Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Wednesday, December 7, 1960.

The Board met at 7:30 P.M. in the American National Bank and Trust Company with all members present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved with one correction. Under item 8, the zoning commission was corrected to read T. C. Melton, Mrs. Zelma Crump and H. P. Spradling.

Police report - Bobby Wilson and Virgil Wilson have signed a note in the amount of \$57 for 3 speeding fines. On October 14 Robert Goad was arrested for public drunkenness, posted \$19 cash bond and did not return for trial. V. B. Jones paid \$1 for a parking ticket.

3. Broken street signs were not discussed.

4. Clerk was asked to write Govern Combs a follow-up letter concerning the police judge appointment.

5. The special tax for the fire truck was successful, the vote being 214 yes to 20 no.

6. Clerk reported that the new vapor lights will cost about the same as the old lights. It is not known exactly when the two additional lights will be installed.

7. There was no further report from the Industrial Development Board.

8. Chairman Jordan suggested that before the Zoning Commission could officially operate, we would need to adopt the 1955 edition of the Bureau of Standards and have an official ordinance drawn up. Trustee Powell made a motion that the 1955 Bureau of Standards be adopted. Trustee Madison seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes. Clerk was authorized to contact A. J. Winkenhofer regarding the ordinance.

9. Trustee Jordan asked for general discussion on Christmas decorations for the town. Due to the fact that all merchants do not burn the colored lights at night and because they need to be strung higher because of the large trucks which use Main Street, Chairman Jordan suggested that perhaps a tree could be placed in the corner of the city park and could be lighted from the fire station. This suggestion was well received. ~~Chairman~~ Joe Lowe and ~~Trustee~~ Bill Powell volunteered to get a tree by Friday. It was suggested that perhaps Bobby Tabor would get the lights ready and the volunteer fireman would help decorate.

10. Chairman Jordan reported that the radio stations and newspapers had been calling asking about when the fire truck would be purchased. He told them we had another year to purchase the truck and decided to wait until the January meeting to appoint a fire truck committee and seriously consider this venture. Several companies have contacted Chairman Jordan concerning this equipment. Members were asked to think about this subject and also to read the Bureau of Standards book.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting the first Wednesday in January, 1961
