1. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

6. Chairman Smith volunteered to contact Mr. W. P. Anderson concerning the cleaning of the ditch lines and also the load of gravel for the street by Henry Larue's.

7. The Christmas lights have been strung for the Holiday season.

8. Clerk reported that a letter had been written to Bell, Orr and Reynolds concerning Jewel T. They are still being asked to pay the \$50.

9. Under new business, Chairman Smith reported that the Executive commitee for the Industrial Development Board had been appointed. These members are Ford Thomas, Jennings Garman and Thomas Webb. They are to select the other members of the Board.

10. Clerk reported that Warren Lindsey had mowed the cemetery for a charge of \$5.

11. Mrs. Jordan, Mrs. Anderson, Mr. Denton and Mr. Thomas commented on the enjoyment of serving as a member of the Board. Mr. Thomas said he was pround of the new Board and felt sure that they would have the support of the retiring members as well as the citizens of Smiths Grove.
