Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Tuesday, February 1, 1966.

The Board met at 7:30 PM at the American National Bank and Trust Company with all members present. The new Police Judge, J. W. Blue was present and Mrs. Carrie Lee Jordan, Cemetery Supervisor was present.

Under new business Chairman Melton had a letter to the effect that no difficulty is anticipated in the request for an increased loan for the water facilities. Due to the fact that the increased loan has not been approved, the Department of Housing and Urban Development would not consent to the awarding of the contracts.

Chairman Melton asked Mrs. Jordan for her report and she gave a detailed report of the various accounts and financial standing and also brought the Board up to date on the present grievances. The discussion of ~~xxxxx~~ an increase in the purchase price of cemetery lots was held and it was decided to wait a while on this.

3. Trustee Powell reported a culvert near Mrs. Cochran's property is falling in. Roy Beckham had made this repair previously and it was decided to get him for this job if possible.

4. Clerk is to write Charlie Hudson regarding the clogged drain on Main Street near the Railroad.

5. Clerk is to write L & N regarding a clogged drain on Railroad Street.

6. The Perkins service station was again discussed. This matter has been held up due to the fact that court action had not been settled. It was reported to the Board that this suit has now been settled and Mr. Perkins is the owner. Clerk was asked to write him concerning the removal of this debris.

7. Trustee Rasdall presented a bill for \$50.37 for his Atlanta trip. Trustee Powell made a motion that we pay this bill. Trustee Blackwell seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.

8. Trustee Rasdall said an individual had reported to him that the Universal Tank Company had erected some unsatisfactory tanks. It was the opinion of the Board that Mr. Rasdall report this to the Engineers and let them investigate.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
