- 4. Due to the severe weather, nothing is being done on the chapel at the cemetery.
- 5. Clerk was asked to order three sets of copies of laws for sixth class cities at a cost of \$3 per set.
- 6. There was no police reports as Mr. Denton and Mr. Keener were not present.
- 7. Hardy account now stands at \$740.00.
- 8. Chairman Bevarly reported he had received word from Senator Natcher that there is no money available for a grant for the purchase of the water system. It had been previously decided to try to obtain the money from other sources if we were not able to secure \*\*x\* a grant.
- 9. Clerk was asked to write the Highway Department regarding the arrow at Main and Sixth, the drainage problem at Main and Sixth, and new signs showing the correct population.
- 10. Engineers from REA had made a survey of the lighting system for the town. Members reviewed this proposal and made several changes. Chairman Bevarly will notify them where to erect the lights which were approved.
