this Street, For Trucks during the week
days But no Truck or Bus. to be
Parked on this (2nd) Street on Sundays

This Amendment was Passed in Order
To give The Truck Operators a Space

To Park Their Trucks when They are Idle
 And with The Understanding That The
 Operators abide by This Amended Regulation
 and show a willingness To Cooperate with
 The Board, otherwise, The Ordinance
 Passed on January 21st will be Enforced
