- 3. A motion was made by Mr. Tarter and seconded by Mr. Denton that Clerk write each of the delinquent taxpayers a notice that if their bill is not paid immediately it will be advertised in the Park City Daily News, if not paid then, property will be sold. There were no dissenting votes.
- 4. It was suggested that City employ Roosevelt Pearson to clean up the parking lot across from Smiths Grove Cleaners.
- 5. The clerk presented a bill for twine from American Hardware Company. Clerk was directed to write to them and find out who purchased same.
- 6. A motion was made by Mr. Tarter and seconded by Mr. Denton that Marshal give parking tickets for one week to warn people of improper parking, then after that they should draw a \$1.00 fine for same. There were no dissenting votes.
