Commissioner Pierce had asked what about Laurel Ave, Highland back to Webb Ave Mr. Methaney had explained that would have to be up to you all, changes can be made once we get this all figured out that we can amend changes Commissioner Watt said he had heard from several citizen as well of their concern on Webb as well Mayor Gilley said well we can go ahead and add it in and if we have to drop anything from the project we will just go from there.

Commissioner Watt had asked about how long this process will take Mr. Mathaney said that he will go ahead and summit the application on February 17, 2004 It would not get looked at until this fall we are looking at the spring of 2005 Commissioner Watt asked Commissioner Cooke if he thought Webb should be included as well, Commissioner Cooke said yes if we had to drop anything we will probable have to drop that one
