Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Tuesday, February 6, 1968.

The Board met in regular session as The American ^National Bank and Trust Company with one member, Trussee James Hill absent. He was attending a zoning meeting in Bowling Green. Visitors were Jack Walker and Jerry Neal Marr.

Tustee Powell reported that the water reading was perfect. He said the problems are minor and can be taken care of. He has been contacted regarding repairing meters. The charge is \$8.

2. Game Blackwell is to check with W. A. Herald regarding the fire department.

3. Jerry Neal Marr was complaining about the construction company not repairing the damage they did. He was objecting to the \$100 hook-on fee. Chairman Melton explained that these charges were set up in Atlanta and we have not no power to change them.

4. Trustee Lowe reported no troubles regarding the cemetery.

5. Trustee Blackwell made a motion that J. B. Garman and F. B. Hardy be allowed to purchase and have installed two vapor street lights near their property. Trustee Powell seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.

6. Judge Blue was present and presented his report for 1967 which is attached. He requested clarification on court cost. It is now \$3. Trustee Blackwell made a motion that this be raised to \$10 including the 50¢ libmary fee. Trustee Lowe seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.

7. A general discussion was held on the damage the Pace Construction Company is doing with heavy trucks. Trustee Powell reported he had contacted them and they have agreed to make repairs. A leak from the Washeteria has been repaired and this is helping the street.

8. The property tax will be increased 10% next for the 1967 taxes in compliance with the State law. It was agreed that the property tax will be .242.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
