 to fix \$10<sup>00</sup> unloading on trucks making  
 regular delivery in town, and must  
 unload at back of place of delivery  
 wherever it be possible to do so,

Motion by J. E. Bohannon, sec. by E. Wade  
 that a special tax of 20 cts per \$100<sup>00</sup>  
 be levied on real estate + personal property  
 for repairing + building streets to be paid  
 on 1938 tax assessment.

Vote was unanimous.

Motion by E. Wade, sec. J. B. Helms that  
 the license for selling beer in the town  
 of Smiths Grove, Ky. be set at \$50<sup>00</sup>  
 due and payable as of Jan. 1 - 1938
