Jan - 3rd - 1939

Meeting continued from Jan - 2 -
Called to order by Chr. Simmons
Members present, Simmons, Bohanon,
Helm + Butler

On motion of J. E. Bohanon, and
seconded by J. B. Helm, all members
voting, "Aye" the tax rate for the
year 1939 was fixed at .50 cts
per One Hundred Dollars on property
values, and Poll tax \$1.50 each male
person over 21 yrs of age and under
70 yrs of age.

Motion by J. B. Helm seconded by
P. N. Butler, all members voting, "Aye"
a special levy of 20¢ per One Hundred
Dollars assessed valuation of Real Estate
& personal property for street improvement
was made.

Motion made and approved that ^{all} licenses
heretofore imposed were to remain
the same as of their original passage
for the fiscal year 1939,
and with the addition of Cream buying
stations, which shall pay a license of
5.⁰⁰ each per year.

Beer License to remain the same
as 1938, namely \$50.⁰⁰ per year each.
Meeting was adjourned to meet
on Monday night Jan. 9, 1939
