Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Tuesday, January 3, 1967.

The Board met at the American National Bank and Trust Company with all members present.

1. Clerk presented the annual financial report.
2. Clerk was asked to advise Mrs. Jordan of the amount the city is to pay for fire hydrants.
3. Trustee Rasdall is to put surplus Water Company money on interest deposit.
4. Clerk was asked to write Kane Mfg. Company to the effect that we would like to have a meeting with them to discuss future plans and inspect possible sites. Clerk is to write the Forestry Division thanking them for locating here.
5. It was the general opinion of the Board that the Streets in the Webb Subdivision need to be repaired. Trustee Powell is to see to getting these graded and rocked. Trustee Rasdall said that we would have to spend some money on the streets because of the defects in the engineering of this water project.
6. Trustee Gene Blackwell is to notify Homer Doyle to move the heater in the fire station.
7. Trustee Rasdall made a motion seconded by Gene Blackwell that all city employees go on social security. There were no dissenting votes.
8. Byron Curtis was a visitor at the meeting representing the Save our Schools Organization. He asked the Board to go on record endorsing their efforts. The Board felt this was an individual decision and each member should act on his own.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
