The Board met in regular session at the American National Bank and Trust Company on Tuesday, January 5, 1971 with two members absent, Trustee Joe Lowe and Trustee Joe Kirn. Not enough members were present to have a quorum but Attorneys Charles English and Maxie Harlin were present to discuss the possibilities of suing the Swift Cheese Company for polluting our water supply. A detailed discussion was held and Mr. English pointed out that we have ample grounds to file a suit. The law firm will take the case on a contingency basis. The attorneys are to make a preliminary investigation to establish the amount of money involved and then will report back to the Board.

Mr. English reminded the Board that the Smiths Grove innerchange will be a very busy one when the Somerset-Bowling Green highway is completed. He stated this could be developed comparable to the Cave City innerchange. He further reminded the Board that at any time we could be required to have a sewer system. He said various grants are available and we should be able to build a sewer system with as much as 50% in grants.

Chairman Melton is to contact Mr. Lyons regarding the amount of money involved for a filter system as this might be required by the State.

Chairman Melton said we need to establish the amount to be charged for the tap-on fees to the East Side water line so these can be collected as the water company needs the money.

Since there were not enough members for a quorum, the Board dismissed.
